



KIDS HAT #01/08

SIZE 0–3 months

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MATERIALS Lamana Como Tweed (100% Merino Superfine, approx. 120 m/25 g) 25 g in color Light Grey shade 42T and Lamana Como (100% Merino Superfine, approx. 120 m/25 g) 25 g in color Curry shade 08, 3 mm knitting needles (US 2/UK 11), cable needle, tapestry needle

PATTERN NOTE Cable pattern over 14 sts:

Row 1 (RS): k 4, p 1, k 4, p 1, k 4

Row 2 (WS): k 2, p 2, k 1, p 4, k 1, p 2, k 2

Row 3 (RS): k 4, p 1, work cable over next 4 sts as follows: slip 2 sts to cn and hold in front of work, k 2, then k 2 from cn, p 1, k 4

Row 4 (WS): as row 2. Rep rows 1-4.

Stockinette stitch: k RS rows, p WS rows

Garner st: k all sts in RS and WS rows

Tension/gauge: 25 sts and 40 rows in st st = 10 × 10 cm

HOW TO The hat is started with cable pattern at lower edge. CO 14 sts with Light Grey and work 136 rows in cable pattern, then BO all sts, cut yarn. With Light Grey pick up 92 sts along right side edge of cable panel (i.e. *pick up 1 st each over first 2 sts of panel edge, skip 3rd st; rep from * to end of cable panel) and work 2 rows in garner st, ending with a WS row. Change to Curry and work 2 rows in st st. Keep on alternating 2 rows in garner st in Light Grey, 2 rows in st st in Curry, after the 5th stripe in Curry (hat measures approx. 9 cm) decrease as follows: work 2 rows in garner st in Light Grey, *at the same time*, in RS row, k tog the 15th and 16th st, then every 14th and 15th st (6 sts decreased; 86 sts left).

Continue stripe pattern as set, at the same time rep decs another 3 times every 4th row (= RS of Light Grey stripe) at the same place (i.e. k tog the 14th and 15th st, then every 13th and 14th st; in second dec row k tog the 13th and 14th st, then every 12th and 13th st and so on). After 4th dec row 68 sts remain on needle. From

now on work decs at the same place every second row, i.e. 6 sts are decreased in Curry colored stripes as well. When only 20 sts are left on needle, cut Light Grey and finish hat in Curry as follows: work 2 rows in st st, then k2tog throughout in 3rd row. Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread through rem 10 sts and secure.

TO FINISH Join back seam, weave in ends. Pull hat over a round object and leave to dry under damp cloth.

k = knit

p = purl

st(s) = stitches

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

cn = cable needle

rep = repeat

st st = stockinette stitch

CO = cast on

BO = bind off

k(2)tog = knit (2) stitches together

dec(s) = decrease(s)
