

## SHAWL \#07/07

SIZE Width about 210 cm , height about 88 cm

MATERIALS Lamana Premia ( $60 \%$ Super Kid Mohair, $40 \%$ Silk,approx. $300 \mathrm{~m} / 25 \mathrm{~g}$ ) 50 g in color Carmine shade $33,25 \mathrm{~g}$ in color Bordeaux shade 16 and 25 g in color Navy shade 11, 4.5 mm knitting needles (UK 7/US 7), 1 dpn of same size, tapestry needle

PATTERN NOTE Garter stitch: $k$ all rows
Stocking stitch: $k$ RS rows, $p$ WS rows
Lace pattern: see instruction
Half brioche stitch: see instruction
Tension/gauge: 15 sts and 30 rows in garter st with 2 threads of yarn held together $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$

HOW TO The shawl is worked with 2 threads of yarn held together throughout and started with a garter tab from centre of the upper edge. CO 3 sts with 2 threads of Carmine and work 7 rows in garter st, do not turn work after last row, *turn tab 90 degrees clockwise, with left hand needle (or dpn) pick up and knit 3 sts along the side, rep from * once more (= 9 sts).
Then work garter stitch with eyelets panel (GP) as follows:
Row 1 (RS): k 3, yo, k 1 , yo, k 1 tbl (= centre st), yo, k 1, yo, k 3 (= 13 sts)
Row 2 (WS) and foll WS rows: $k$ all sts, purl centre st tbl
Row 3 (RS): k 3, yo, k 3, yo, k 1 tbl (= centre st), yo, k 3, yo, k 3 (= 17 sts)
Row 5 (RS): k 3, yo, k 5, yo, k 1 tbl (= centre st), yo, k 5, yo k 3 (= 21 sts).
Continue as given for a total of 24 rows ( $=12$ ridges): in each RS row 4 sts are increased, finally there are 23 sts between centre and border eyelets ( $=57$ sts in total).

Now work a stocking stitch with eyelets panel (SP) over 6 rows as follows:
RS rows: work as given for GP

WS rows: k 4 , p to 1 st before centre st, $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p}$ centre st tbl, $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p}$ to last 4 sts, k 4 .

Then work lace panel (LP) over 4 rows as follows:
Row 1 (RS): work as given for GP
Row 2 (WS): k all sts, purl centre st tbl
Row 3 (RS): k 3, yo, *k 2 tog, yo, rep from * to 1 st before centre st, p $1, \mathrm{k}$ centre st tbl, p 1,**yo , k 2 tog tbl, rep from ${ }^{* *}$ to last 3 sts, yo, k 3
Row 4 (WS): as row 2.

Continue as follows: $1 \mathrm{SP}, 1 \mathrm{LP}, 1 \mathrm{SP}$, GP over 16 rows (8 ridges), $1 \mathrm{SP}, 1 \mathrm{LP}, 1 \mathrm{SP}, 1 \mathrm{LP}, 1 \mathrm{SP}$, GP over 12 rows (6 ridges).

Now replace one strand of Carmine with a strand of Bordeaux and work as follows: GP over 6 rows (3 ridges), 1 SP, 1 LP, 1 SP, 1 LP.

Continue with 2 strands of Bordeaux as follows: 1 SP, GP over 4 rows (2 ridges).

Replace one strand of Bordeaux with one strand of Navy and work GP over 16 rows (8 ridges).

Continue with 2 strands of Navy and work half brioche st as follows:
Row 1 (RS): k 3, yo,*k 1 , yf sl1 yo, rep from * to 1 st before centre st, k 1 , yo, $k$ centre st tbl, yo, k $1, *$ yf sl1 yo, k 1 , rep from ${ }^{* *}$ to last 3 sts, yo, k3
Row 2 (WS): $\mathrm{k} 4,{ }^{*} \mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$ tog with yo, rep from * to 2 sts before centre st, p $1, \mathrm{k} 1$ (= yo of prev row), p centre st tbl, k 1 (= yo of prev row), p 1, ** k 1 tog with yo, p 1, rep from ** to last 4 sts, k 4
Row 3 (RS): k 3, yo, *yf sl1 yo, k 1, rep from * to 1 st before centre st, yf sl1 yo, yo, k centre st tbl, yo, ** yf sl1 yo, k 1 , rep from ${ }^{* *}$ to last 4 sts, yf sl1 yo, yo, k 3
Row 4 (WS): $\mathrm{k} 4, \mathrm{k} 1$ tog with yo, ${ }^{*} \mathrm{p} 1$, k 1 tog with yo, rep from * to $1 \mathrm{st}(=$ yo) before centre st, $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p}$ centre st tbl, k $1, \mathrm{k} 1$ tog with yo, ${ }^{* *} \mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$ tog with yo, rep from ${ }^{* *}$ to last 4 sts, k 4 . Repeat rows $1-4$ for pattern and work 10 rows in half brioche st.

Then work an I-Cord BO as follows: at beginning of following RS row CO 2 more sts, k these 2 sts, slip them purlwise wyib to left hand needle and continue as follows: ${ }^{*} \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{k} 2$ tog tbl, sl these 2 sts purlwise wyib to left hand needle, rep from * to last 2 sts, k 2 tog tbl.

TO FINISH Weave in ends. Lightly stretch piece and leave under damp towel until dry.

CO = cast on
BO = bind off
RS = right side
WS = wrong side
dpn = double pointed needle
yo = yarn over
sl = slip
tbl = through back loop
k 2 tog = knit 2 sts together
yf sl1 yo = with yarn in front slip 1 st purlwise, then yarn over
wyib = with yarn in back
prev = previous
rep = repeat
