SIZE Length approx. 200 cm/78.7", width approx. 54 cm/21.3"

 $\label{eq:materials} \textbf{MATERIALS} \ Lamana \ Premia \ (60\% \ Super \ Kid \ Mohair, \ 40\% \ Silk, \ approx. \ 300 \ m/25 \ g) \ 100 \ g \ in \ color \ Kiwi \ shade \ 66,$ 

3.25 mm (US 3/UK 10) needles, 1 tapestry needle

PATTERN NOTE Lace pattern 1 and 2: see charts 1 and 2: charts show only RS rows; in WS rows work the 3-st selvedge as established, purl all remaining stitches and yos
3-st selvedge: RS: k 1, sl 1 wyif, k 1; WS: sl 1 wyif, k 1, sl 1 wyif
Gauge: 23 sts and 34 rows in lace pattern 1 = 10 × 10 cm/4" square
(Please adjust needle size if necessary to obtain correct gauge)


**HOW TO** CO 127 sts and work set-up row as follows: work 3-st selvedge (this selvedge will be worked over the first and last 3 sts of every row throughout the entire pattern), k 121, 3-st selvedge. Work 6 rows as set.

In next RS row start working according to lace pattern 1 as follows: work 8 *Start*-sts, then work pattern repeat (10 sts) 11 times, finally work 9 *End*-sts. Rep the 24 rows of pattern 1 up to approx. 6 cm/2.4" from desired length, ending with row 24. Work lace pattern 2 once, then k 6 rows, continuing the 3-st selvedge at beg and end of rows as established.

Next RS row: work a Russian BO as follows: \*p2tog, sl just formed st back onto LH-needle (wyib), rep from \* until end of row. Fasten off.

TO FINISH Carefully stretch the stole on a soft surface and leave to dry under damp cloths.
