



SHAWL LUISE #E06

MEASUREMENTS See schematic drawing

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MATERIALS LAMANA Roma (80% Cashmere, 20% Silk, approx. 160 m/20 g) 20 g in Silver Grey 05, knitting needles size 4 mm (US 6/UK 8), 1 tapestry needle

ABOUT The explanations of the abbreviations used in this pattern and the stitch symbols used in the charts can be found on last 2 pages

PATTERN NOTE

Stockinette stitch (st st): knit the RS rows and purl the WS rows

3 sts selvedge (3 sts ES):

(This selvedge is worked at the beg and end of *every* row)

RS: k 1, sl 1 st purlwise (with yarn in front of work, wyif), k 1

WS: sl 1 st purlwise (wyif), k 1, sl 1 st purlwise (wyif)

Lace pattern (LP) over 5 sts and 16 rows:

Row 1 (RS): 1 yo, skp (sl 1 st knitwise, k 1, pass slipped st over), k 3

(Exception: On the first pattern repeat at the tip at the bottom of the shawl (= row 17), only 2 sts are knitted at the end of the row and then 1 right leaning knit st is increased)

Row 2 (WS – and all foll WS rows): purl all sts

Row 3 (RS): 1 yo, k 1, skp, k 2

Row 5 (RS): 1 yo, k 2, skp, k 1

Row 7 (RS): 1 yo, k 3, skp

Row 9 (RS): k 3, k2tog, 1 yo

Row 11 (RS): k 2, k2tog, k 1, 1 yo

Row 13 (RS): k 1, k2tog, k 2, 1 yo

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Row 15 (RS): k2tog, k 3, 1 yo. Keep repeating rows 1-16

(The lace pattern is shown as a red-bordered pattern repeat in the charts)

Increase 1 [Right leaning increase from bar between 2 sts, knitwise (M1Rk)]: using LH-ndl tip, pick up the bar between the st on LH-ndl and the st on RH-ndl, from back to front, and knit this st through front loop

Increase 2 [Right leaning increase from bar between 2 sts, purlwise (M1Rp)]: using LH-ndl tip, pick up the bar between the st on LH-ndl and the st on RH-ndl, from back to front, and purl this st through front loop
(this inc is only worked on rows 21 and 25)

Gauge/Tension: 21 sts and 30 rows, using ndl size 4 mm (US 6/UK 8) and worked in st st = 10 × 10 cm / 4" square

(Please adjust needle size if necessary, to obtain correct gauge)

HOW TO The narrow shawl with lace pattern border is worked from just one ball of Roma and starts on the left side.

CO 7 sts and work as follows *(The first 47 rows of the shawl are also shown in chart 1. Only the RS rows are shown; on WS rows work sts, between the 2 selvages on both sides of the work, as they appear):*

Row 1 (RS): 3 sts ES [i.e.: k 1, sl 1 st purlwise (wyif), k 1], k 1, 3 sts ES (as described)

Row 2 (WS): 3 sts ES [i.e.: sl 1 st purlwise (wyif), k 1, sl 1 st purlwise (wyif)], p 1, 3 sts ES (as described)

Rows 3 and 4: as rows 1 and 2

Row 5 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 1, M1Rk, 3 sts ES (1 st increased, 8 sts in total)

Row 6 (WS – and all foll WS rows): 3 sts ES, work sts as they appear to last 3 sts, 3 sts ES

Row 7 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 2, 3 sts ES

Row 9 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 2, M1Rk, 3 sts ES (+ 1 st; 9 sts)

Row 11 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 3, 3 sts ES

Row 13 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 3, M1Rk, 3 sts ES (+ 1 st; 10 sts)

Row 15 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 4, 3 sts ES.

In next row, work first row of LP (row 1).

(Attention: In this row, LP doesn't end with 3 knit sts, but with 2 knit sts and M1Rk; all future patt reps are worked in pattern as described)

Row 17 (RS): 3 sts ES, 1 yo, skp, k 2, M1Rk, 3 sts ES (+ 1 st; 11 sts)

Row 19 (RS): 3 sts ES, 1 yo, k 1, skp, k 2, 3 sts ES

Row 21 (RS): 3 sts ES, 1 yo, k 2, skp, k 1, M1Rp (!), 3 sts ES (+ 1 st; 12 sts)

Row 23 (RS): 3 sts ES, 1 yo, k 3, skp, p 1, 3 sts ES

Row 25 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 3, k2tog, 1 yo, p 1, M1Rp (!), 3 sts ES (+ 1 st; 13 sts)

Row 27 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 2, k2tog, k 1, 1 yo, p 2, 3 sts ES.

After this row, the lace pattern border (consisting of 5 sts lace pattern and 2 purl sts, which are worked after the 5 lace pattern sts) has reached its final width.

All inc's (which are now worked in every 4th row) are worked directly after the 2 purl sts. Only right leaning knitted inc's are worked from now on.

Row 29 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 1, k2tog, k 2, 1 yo, p 2, M1Rk, 3 sts ES (+ 1 st; 14 sts)

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Row 31 (RS): 3 sts ES, k2tog, k 3, 1 yo, p 2, k 1, 3 sts ES.

After next WS row (**row 32**), the first patt rep of LP is finished. In next RS row, continue working acc to row 1 of LP.

Row 33 (RS): 3 sts ES, 1 yo, skp, k 3, p 2, M1Rk, k 1, 3 sts ES (+ 1 st; 15 sts)

Row 35 (RS): 3 sts ES, 1 yo, k 1, skp, k 2, p 2, k 2, 3 sts ES

Row 37 (RS): 3 sts ES, 1 yo, k 2, skp, k 1, p 2, M1Rk, k 2, 3 sts ES (16 sts)

Row 39 (RS): 3 sts ES, 1 yo, k 3, skp, p 2, k 3, 3 sts ES

Row 41 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 3, k2tog, 1 yo, p 2, M1Rk, k 3, 3 sts ES (17 sts)

Row 43 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 2, k2tog, k 1, 1 yo, p 2, k 4, 3 sts ES

Row 45 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 1, k2tog, k 2, 1 yo, p 2, M1Rk, k 4, 3 sts ES (18 sts)

Row 47 (RS): 3 sts ES, k2tog, k 3, 1 yo, p 2, k 5, 3 sts ES.

After next WS row, second patt rep of LP is finished.

Continue working as set, keep repeating LP upwards and always inc 1 st after the 2 purl sts in every 4th row (or 2nd RS row), until after **row 185** (a RS row and a 9th row of patt rep), 53 sts are on the needle; these are distributed as follows: 3 sts ES, 5 sts LP, p 2, 40 sts st st, 3 sts ES.

Work 3 more rows in pattern, beg and end with a WS row, then start decreasing, as follows:

Row 189 (RS): Work first 10 sts of RS row in pattern [i.e.: 3 sts ES, 5 sts LP (row 13 of patt rep), p 2], then k2tog, work rem sts in pattern.

From now on, work these dec's in every 4th row (i.e.: every 2nd RS row), always directly after the 2 purl sts, until after the, in total, 38th dec (in **row 337**) only 15 sts are left on the needle and between the purl sts and the selvedge sts at the end of row are only 2 knit sts (*in this row, 1st pattern-row of LP is worked*).

Row 337, and also foll rows up to the tip of shawl, are also shown in chart 2; only the RS rows are shown, on WS rows work sts, as they appear, beg and end with 3 sts selvedge.

Row 339 (RS): 3 sts ES, 5 sts LP (3rd pattern-row), p 2, k 2, 3 sts ES

Row 341 (RS): 3 sts ES, 5 sts LP (5th pattern-row), p 2, k2tog, 3 sts ES (- 1 st; 14 sts)

Row 343 (RS): 3 sts ES, 5 sts LP (7th pattern-row), p 2, k 1, 3 sts ES

Row 345 (RS): 3 sts ES, 5 sts LP (9th pattern-row), p 2, k2tog, 2 (!) sts ES (- 1 st; 13 sts).

In next WS row, work (as before) first 3 sts as 3 ES, work rem sts in pattern.

Row 347 (RS): 3 sts ES, 5 sts LP (11th pattern-row), p 2, 3 sts ES

Row 349 (RS): 3 sts ES, 5 sts LP (13th pattern-row), p 1, k2tog, 2 (!) sts ES (- 1 st; 12 sts).

In next WS row, work (as before) first 3 sts as 3 ES, work rem sts in pattern.

Row 351 (RS): 3 sts ES, 5 sts LP (15th pattern-row) p 1, 3 sts ES.

After this row, LP is finished. From next RS row only work st st between the selvedges.

Row 353 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 5, k2tog, 2 (!) sts ES (- 1 st; 11 sts)

In next WS row, work (as before) first 3 sts as 3 ES, work rem sts in pattern.

Row 355 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 5, 3 sts ES

Row 357 (RS): 3 sts ES, skp, k 3, 3 sts ES (- 1 st; 10 sts)

Row 359 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 4, 3 sts ES

Row 361 (RS): 3 sts ES, skp, k 2, 3 sts ES (- 1 st; 9 sts)

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Row 363 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 3, 3 sts ES

Row 365 (RS): 3 sts ES, skip, k 1, 3 sts ES (- 1 st; 8 sts)

Row 367 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 2, 3 sts ES

Row 369 (RS): 3 sts ES, skip, 3 sts ES (- 1 st; 7 sts)

Row 371 (RS): 3 sts ES, k 1, 3 sts ES.

Work 1 more WS row, then BO all sts.

TO FINISH Weave in all yarn ends. Carefully pin the shawl to measurements onto a flat surface, cover with damp clothes and leave to dry.

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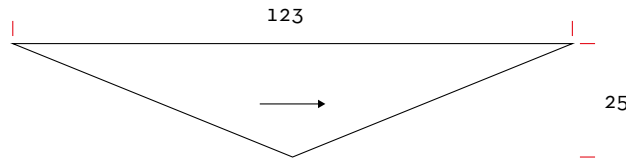
